Route Summary: Short walk between the stations along the River Coly



Description: - [1] Start at the Colyton Station - Walk down the road past the columns of an old railway bridge - now dismantled - turn left into Cowhayne Lane - Continue for a short on-road stretch then go through kiss gate and cross field to the large footbridge - Here you have joined the East Devon Way.

[2] Turn right over the footbridge and follow the East Devon way markers to Colyton -

Or

[3] Follow the path down by the side of the River Coly - After a while you will reach a junction in the footpaths.

[4] At this junction you can turn left and follow the East Devon Way markers to Musbury and beyond to Lyme Regis.

Or

[5] Follow the Link waymarkers down the river Coly - Eventually you will emerge near the Colyford Tramway Station at Colyford - Take care crossing the road to the Station or the pub - from here you can take the Tram back to Colyton or to Seaton.

Or

[6] Turn left and cross the Tramway into Cowhayne Lane - Walk up Cowhayne Lane - after a short distance turn left onto the East Devon Way and return to Colyton.

Or

[7] Walk a bit further and join the East Devon Way to Musbury or Whitford.
